Luneau

Present law provides a procedure for the sale of public lands.

Authorizes commissioner of administration and LDH to transfer certain property related to the Central Louisiana Hospital in Rapides Parish pursuant to present law.

Authorizes the commissioner of administration and the secretary of DOTD to transfer certain property to the Louisiana Department of Health.

Authorizes the commissioner of administration and the secretary of DOTD to transfer certain property in Rapides Parish to the town of Boyce.

<u>Proposed law</u> creates the Louisiana Department of Health's Facility Support Fund Number 2 and provides for the transfer, use, and investment of monies in the fund.

Requires that after subtracting costs incurred by the division of administration related to the sale of the Central Louisiana State Hospital properties, the proceeds of any sale be paid into the LDH Facility Support Fund Number 2 and dedicated to the planning, design, permits, improvements, repairs, equipment, restoration, renovation, or construction of the Central Louisiana State Hospital.

Effective August 1, 2019.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Finance to the original bill

- 1. Deletes authorization for the commissioner of administration and the secretary of DCFS to transfer certain property in Jackson Parish to the Greater North Louisiana Community Development Corporation.
- 2. Adds authorization for the commissioner of administration and the secretary of DOTD to transfer certain property to the Louisiana Department of Health.
- 3. Creates the Louisiana Department of Health's Facility Support Fund Number 2, and provides for the transfer, use, and investment of monies in the fund.
- 4. Provides that monies in the fund may also be used for planning, design, permits, improvements, repairs and equipment.
- 5. Clarifies that the proceeds from the transactions described in Sections 2 and 3 shall be deposited in the state treasury in accordance with <u>present law</u>.
