EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed law will result in a one-time increase of \$67,150 SGF for the Department of State to provide privacy screens and curtains at early voting locations in order to accommodate early voting watchers. The Department of State indicates they would need privacy screens for 113 ERIN desktops and 51 early voting laptops at an estimated cost of \$16,620. In addition, the department indicates there are 32 early voting sites that do not currently have privacy curtains and related equipment for the early voting machines. The estimated cost for the privacy curtains and related equipment is approximately \$50,530.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
