EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed law will result in an indeterminable but nominal increase in SGF expenditures for the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to provide specific suitable accommodations for breastfeeding and lactation. The department reports that implementation may be problematic as a result of the temporary housing of the female inmates at Jetson Correctional Center and Elayn Hunt Correctional Center due to limited space at those facilities. However, the department plans to implement such accommodations into the new Louisiana Correctional Institute for Women facility once constructed.

To the extent state female inmates are housed in local facilities, there is a potential indeterminable increase in local funds expenditures to local governing authorities to comply with proposed law. This cost could potentially be mitigated to the extent DPSC could place state female inmates in local facilities with appropriate breastfeeding and lactation accommodations. The prevalence of such facilities among local incarceration units is unknown.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
