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Provides relative to facilities providing housing to individuals referred by judicial agencies. (8/1/16)

Proposed law amends and reenact certain areas in R.S. 40:2852(D) and (E), relative to facilities providing housing or temporary residence for individuals arrested for commission of a crime, removes accreditation requirements and provides for related matters.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on state governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. Proposed law removes the American Correctional Association (ACA) accreditation requirements within 24-months of opening for all facilities referred by judicial agencies (i.e. district courts and officers, including the district judge, the prosecutor and district attorneys) as a residential facility. The Department of Public Safety and Corrections - Correction Services reports this will impact one facility offering diversion services in Lacassine, Louisiana. Currently, placements at the facility are primarily made by district court(s) and district attorney(s) as alternative placements. The facility's website reports that its expenses are paid by referred individuals at a cost of \$62.50 per day.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on state governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
