The original instrument and the following digest, which constitutes no part of the legislative instrument, were prepared by Margaret M. Corley.

DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> provides for the Firefighters' Retirement System (FRS) board of trustees to be made up of ten members:

- (1) Two members of the Professional Firefighters Association.
- (2) A fire chief who is chief of a fire department participating in the system.
- (3) Two mayors appointed by the Louisiana Municipal Association.
- (4) Chairman of the House of Representatives Committee on Retirement.
- (5) Chairman of the Senate Committee on Retirement.
- (6) A retiree of the system.
- (7) The state treasurer.
- (8) The commissioner of administration.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for an additional retiree representative to serve on the FRS board of trustees.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the number of board members from 10 to 11.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the number of affirmative votes necessary for a decision of the board from five to six.

Effective June 30, 2014.
