On a third or subsequent conviction, except as provided in Subsection E 17 18 of this Section, the offender shall be fined not more than two thousand five hundred 19 dollars, or imprisoned, with or without hard labor, for not more than two years, or both. 20

D. If the second or subsequent conviction is by any person licensed under the occupational license tax law, as provided in R.S. 47:341 et seq., or by such person's manager, agent, servant, or employee, then such person shall forfeit the right to any permit issued thereunder and such permit may be suspended or revoked. The provisions of this Subsection shall not apply to drug paraphernalia intended for or used solely for marijuana.

E. On a first conviction or any subsequent conviction for a violation of the provisions of this Part involving the use or possession of drug paraphernalia intended for the use of marijuana or used to store, contain, or package marijuana, or to ingest or inhale marijuana, the offender shall be fined not more than fifty dollars.

Abstract: Reduces the penalty for possession or use of marijuana drug paraphernalia.

<u>Present law</u> provides for penalties for violations of law regarding the possession, sale, and use of drug paraphernalia.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that on a first or subsequent conviction for a violation regarding the use or possession of drug paraphernalia for the use of marijuana or when used to store, contain, or package marijuana, or to ingest or inhale marijuana, the offender shall be fined not more than \$50.
