PROPERTY/PUBLIC: Provides relative to certain state property

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 48:954, relative to the acquisition and sale of state bridges and linear parks by
3 local governments; to prohibit certain municipalities and parishes from acquiring or
4 transferring an interest in state bridges and linear bridges; and to provide for related
5 matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 48:954 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, it shall be unlawful for
9 any municipality with a population greater than one hundred fifty thousand and less
10 than two hundred thousand, or any parish with a population greater than two hundred
11 twenty thousand and less than two hundred forty thousand, according to the latest
12 federal decennial census to acquire or transfer any interest in a bridge owned by the
13 state or a bridge or similar structure that may be deemed, described, designated, or
14 defined as a linear park.

Abstract: Prohibits certain parishes and municipalities from acquiring or transferring state bridges or linear parks.

Proposed law prohibits the acquisition or transfer of interest in state owned bridges or linear parks by certain municipalities and parishes.

Proposed law specifies the parishes and municipalities subject to the prohibition by population designation.
