Abstract: Exempts attorneys licensed as real estate salespersons from certain requirements for licensure as a real estate broker.

<u>Present law</u> requires all applicants for licensure as a real estate broker in this state to be licensed for 4 years prior to application as a real estate broker and complete 150 hours of instruction in real estate courses, including passage of an examination on course contents.

<u>Proposed law</u> exempts attorneys licensed and in good standing with the La. State Bar Association who are also licensed real estate salespersons from the requirements set forth in present law.
