2	To enact R.S. 40:1379.3(D)(4), relative to concealed handgun permits; to provide with

4	firearms safety courses shall not be required for concealed handgun permit renewals
5	in certain circumstances; and to provide for related matters.

14	the provisions of this Section shall not be required to complete any handgun or

McVea HB No. 11

Abstract: Provides that a person with a concealed handgun permit shall not be required to complete safety training courses for renewal of the permit if the permit has never been suspended or revoked.

Present law provides for the issuance of concealed handgun permits.

<u>Present law</u>, with respect to issuance of a permit, provides for a demonstration of competency with a handgun as provided by completion of certain firearms training and safety courses.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that firearms safety and training courses shall not be required for a renewal of the permit if the permit has never been suspended or revoked.
