HIGHWAYS: Designates a bridge located on Louisiana Highway 154 in Bossier Parish as  
the "Officer Thomas LaValley Memorial Bridge"

1 AN ACT

2 To designate a bridge located on Louisiana Highway 154 in Bossier Parish as the "Officer  
3 Thomas LaValley Memorial Bridge"; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. The Louisiana Highway 154 bridge which crosses the south end of Lake  
6 Bistineau in Bossier Parish shall be hereinafter known and designated as the "Officer  
7 Thomas LaValley Memorial Bridge".

8 Section 2. The Department of Transportation and Development and its contractors  
9 are hereby directed to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this designation.
