CORRECTIONS: Provides with respect to court-ordered probation supervision fees

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact Code of Criminal Procedure Article 895.1(F)(introductory
3 paragraph), relative to fees for supervised probation; to provide for an increase in the
4 supervised probation fees dedicated to the Sex Offender Registry Technology Fund;
5 and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. Code of Criminal Procedure Article 895.1(F)(introductory paragraph) is
8 hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

9 Art. 895.1. Probation; restitution; judgment for restitution; fees

10 * * *

11 F. When the court places the defendant on supervised probation, it shall
12 order as a condition of probation the payment of a monthly fee of not less than ~~five~~
13 ~~dollars and fifty cents~~ eleven dollars. The monthly fee established in this Paragraph
14 shall be in addition to the fee established in Paragraph C of this Article and shall be
15 collected by the Department of Public Safety and Corrections and shall be
16 transmitted, deposited, appropriated, and used in accordance with the following
17 provisions:

Abstract: Increases the court-ordered probation supervision fees dedicated to the Sex Offender Registry Technology Fund.

Present law authorizes the court to order as a condition of probation the payment of a monthly fee of not less than \$5.50 to be dedicated to the Sex Offender Registry Technology Fund.

Proposed law changes the amount of the fee from not less than \$5.50 to not more than \$11.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice to the original bill.

1. Removed provisions regarding the late fee assessment for failure to timely pay probation fees.
2. Added an increase in court-ordered probation supervision fees dedicated to the Sex Offender Registry Technology Fund.
