The director shall, through the office of workers' compensation 13 administration, promulgate rules in accordance with the Administrative Procedure 14 Act, R.S. 49:950, et seq., to establish a medical treatment schedule. 15 (1) Such rules shall be promulgated no later than September 30, 2010 16 January 1, 2011. * 17 18 J. After a medical provider has submitted to the payor the request for 19 authorization and the information required by the Louisiana Administrative Code, 20 Title 40, Chapter 27, the payor shall notify the medical provider of their action on 21 the request within five business days of receipt of the request. If any dispute arises 22 after September 30, 2010 January 1, 2011, as to whether the recommended care, 23 services, or treatment is in accordance with the medical treatment schedule, or 24 whether a variance from the medical treatment schedule is reasonably required as

1	contemplated in Subsection I of this Section, any aggrieved party shall file, within
2	fifteen calendar days, an appeal with the office of workers' compensation
3	administration medical director on a form promulgated by the director. The medical
4	director shall render a decision as soon as is practicable, but in no event, not more
5	than thirty calendar days from the date of filing.

7	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not

signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
effective on the day following such approval.
