APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Appropriates funds for payment of the consent judgment against the state in the case entitled Tommy Herring v. Vance McAlister, et al.

AN ACT

2 To appropriate monies out of the state general fund for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 to be used to 3 pay the consent judgment captioned "Tommy Herring versus Vance McAlister, Kelly 4 McAlister and the State of Louisiana through the Department of Transportation and 5 Development" between the state of Louisiana, through the Department of 6 Transportation and Development, and Tommy Herring; to provide for an effective 7 date; and to provide for related matters. 8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 9 Section 1. The sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 (\$2,500) Dollars 10 is hereby payable out of the State General Fund (Direct) for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 for 11 payment of the consent judgment captioned "Tommy Herring versus Vance McAlister, Kelly 12 McAlister and the State of Louisiana through the Department of Transportation and 13 Development", signed on September 14, 2021, between the state of Louisiana, through the 14 Department of Transportation and Development, and Tommy Herring, bearing Number 19-15 0988, on the docket of the Fourth Judicial District, parish of Ouachita, state of Louisiana. 16 Section 2. The judgment may only be paid from this appropriation if it is final and 17 shall be paid as to principal, interest, court costs, and expert witness fees as awarded in the 18 judgment. If the provisions of the judgment conflict with the provisions of this Act, the 19 provisions of the judgment shall be controlling. Any other provision of this Act not in 20 conflict with the provisions of the judgment shall control. Payment shall be made only after

- 1 presentation to the state treasurer of documentation required by the state treasurer. Further,
- 2 the judgment shall be deemed to have been paid on the effective date of this Act, and interest
- 3 shall cease to run as of that date.
- 4 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
- 5 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
- by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
- 7 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
- 8 effective on the day following such approval.
