AN ACT

2	To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2012-
3	2013 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Weeks Marine, Inc.
4	v. Delta Towing, LLC, and the Louisiana Department of Transportation and
5	Development, and Kimberly Young"; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. The sum of Eighty-Eight Thousand Five Hundred and No/100
8	(\$88,500.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana
9	for Fiscal Year 2012-2013 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Weeks
10	Marine, Inc. v. Delta Towing, LLC, and the Louisiana Department of Transportation and
11	Development, and Kimberly Young", bearing Number 111-384, Division "E", on the docket
12	of the Seventeenth Judicial District Court, parish of Lafourche, state of Louisiana.
13	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2012; if vetoed by the governor
14	and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
15	2012, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
