Abstract: Removes the requirement that the social security number of each applicant be included on the application for a marriage license.

Present law provides for certain required identifying information to be included in an application for a marriage license. Such required information includes the names and addresses of the applicants, dates of birth, names of the parents, and social security numbers. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but removes the requirement that the social security number of each applicant be included on the application.
