HOUSE BILL NO. 122

BY REPRESENTATIVE HENRY

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds and to make and otherwise provide for certain reductions in
3 appropriations from certain sources to be allocated to designated agencies and
4 purposes in specific amounts for the making of supplemental appropriations and
5 reductions for said agencies and purposes for the 2015-2016 Fiscal Year; to provide
6 for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

1 Section 1.G. The commissioner of administration is authorized to make adjustments
2 to appropriations as are necessary to effectuate the governor's deficit plan approved by the
3 Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget on February 15, 2016, and as provided in this
4 Act, after review of the adjustments by the Legislative Fiscal Office.

5 Section 2. The state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer monies
6 from the State General Fund by Fees and Self-generated Revenues from the Department of
7 Veterans Affairs in the amount of \$5,100,000 into the State General Fund (Direct).

8 Section 3. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the secretary of the
9 Department of Health and Hospitals shall take any action necessary to control costs and
10 achieve maximum efficiency in the Pediatric Day Health Care Program in an effort to ensure
11 that the program serves only the most medically fragile children.

12 Section 4.A. Notwithstanding any provision of the law to the contrary, the state
13 treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer State Bond Commission Fees and Self-
14 generated Revenues in the amount of (\$8,000,000) into the State General Fund.

15 Section 4.B. In the event that the State Bond Commission approves and issues state
16 general obligation refunding bonds before May 1, 2016, the transaction shall be structured
17 to achieve maximum cash flow savings of approximately Eighty Million Dollars in Fiscal
18 Year 2015-2016 and any additional savings in Fiscal Year 2016-2017 which cash flow
19 savings shall be used to assist in eliminating the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 and Fiscal Year
20 2016-2017 deficits.

21 Section 5. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer
22 is hereby authorized and directed to transfer to the State General Fund (Direct) the amounts
23 of any reduction in State General Fund by Fees and Self-generated Revenues, Statutory
24 Dedications, or Interagency Transfers reduced as provided or recognized in this Act, and the
25 amounts of any reductions in State General Fund by Fees and Self-generated Revenues or
26 Statutory Dedications approved and certified by the Joint Legislative Committee on the
27 Budget on February 15, 2016. The state treasurer shall make such transfers from each fund
28 prior to fully funding the appropriation from the fund. Within ten days after the effective
29 date of this Act, the state treasurer shall make all transfers provided in Sections 1.A. through
30 2 of this Act. In the event that the amount of any reduction in State General Fund by Fees
31 and Self-generated Revenues, Statutory Dedications, or Interagency Transfers being

1 transferred to the State General Fund (Direct) are insufficient to fully fund the reduction
 2 made from such fund source on that date following the effective date of this Act or on that
 3 date the amount remaining in Fees and Self-generated Revenues, Statutory Dedications, or
 4 Interagency Transfers is insufficient to fully fund the reductions required by this Act and the
 5 appropriation remaining after the reductions in this Act, the treasurer shall notify the
 6 commissioner of administration and the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget. The
 7 state treasurer shall make the remaining transfers in this Act prior to the end of Fiscal Year
 8 2015-2016. In the event the amount of Fees and Self-generated Revenues or Statutory
 9 Dedications being transferred to the State General Fund (Direct) are insufficient to fully fund
 10 the transfers required in those Sections, the treasurer shall notify the commissioner of
 11 administration and the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget.

12 Section 6. In accordance with the provisions of Article VII, Section 10(E) of the
 13 Constitution of Louisiana, appropriations by the legislature from the state general fund and
 14 dedicated funds for any fiscal year shall not exceed the official forecast in effect at the time
 15 the appropriations were made. In the event that sufficient revenues are not generated in the
 16 2016 First Extraordinary Session of the Legislature in order to eliminate the total current
 17 year deficit as reported to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget on November 20,
 18 2015 and February 13, 2016, which deficit includes both the February 10, 2016, reductions
 19 in the official forecast and the current year expenditure items requiring action as contained
 20 in the Fiscal Status Statement as adopted by the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget
 21 on February 13, 2016, excluding the expenditure item listed as "preamble reductions",
 22 accounting for any changes in the most recently projected amount of each current year
 23 expenditure item requiring action, the commissioner of administration shall make such
 24 adjustments and reductions as are necessary to ensure that the appropriations for the current
 25 fiscal year eliminate the deficit enumerated above.

26 Section 7. Act 26 of the 2015 Regular Session of the Legislature is hereby amended
 27 and reenacted as follows:

28 On page 28, delete lines 29 and 30, and insert the following:

29 "Payable from the State General Fund by Interagency
 30 Transfers from the Office of Motor Vehicles in the
 31 event HB No. 111 of the 2016 First Extraordinary
 32 Session of the Legislature is enacted into law \$ 24,000,000"

1 On page 28, at the end of line 41, change "\$611,530,624" to "\$618,530,624"

2 Section 8. The state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer out of the
3 State General Fund by Statutory Dedications from the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Deficit
4 Elimination Fund the amount of \$200,000,000 into the State General Fund (Direct) to
5 provide a source of funds to eliminate all or a portion of the Fiscal Year 2015-2016
6 budgetary deficit.

7 Section 9. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
8 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
9 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
10 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
11 effective on the day following such approval.
