1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 14:95.1(C), relative to the possession of a firearm or carrying a
3	concealed weapon by a person convicted of certain felonies; to remove the
4	authorization for law enforcement to issue permits allowing certain felons to possess
5	firearms or carry concealed weapons; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 14:95.1(C) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§95.1. Possession of firearm or carrying concealed weapon by a person convicted
9	of certain felonies
10	* * *
11	C. Except as otherwise specifically provided, this Section shall not apply to
12	the following cases:
13	(1) The provisions of this Section prohibiting the possession of firearms and
14	carrying concealed weapons by persons who have been convicted of certain felonies
15	shall not apply to any person who has not been convicted of any felony for a period
16	of ten years from the date of completion of sentence, probation, parole, or suspension
17	of sentence.
18	(2) Upon completion of sentence, probation, parole, or suspension of
19	sentence the convicted felon shall have the right to apply to the sheriff of the parish
20	in which he resides, or in the case of Orleans Parish the superintendent of police, for
21	a permit to possess firearms. The felon shall be entitled to possess the firearm upon
22	the issuing of the permit.

1	(3) The sheriff or superintendent of police, as the case may be, shall
2	immediately notify the Department of Public Safety, in writing, of the issuance of
3	each permit granted under this Section.
