AN ACT

2	To enact Part I-B of Chapter 2 of Title 51 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, to be	
3	comprised of R.S. 51:501, relative to warranty claims; to require claims to be	
4	approved or disapproved within thirty days; to require payment of approved claims	
5	within thirty days; to require notice of disapproval and the grounds for the	
6	disapproval; to provide for claims not disapproved within thirty days; to provide for	
7	claims submitted after the termination of a contract; to provide for compensation for	
8	work performed by a dealer; to provide for excluded expenses; to provide for	
9	compensation for parts; to provide for a supplier's right to adjust for errors; to	
10	authorize a dealer to accept a manufacturer's reimbursement terms; to define	
11	"dealer"; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.	
12	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:	
13	Section 1. Part I-B of Chapter 2 of Title 51 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of	
14	1950, comprised of R.S. 51:501, is hereby enacted to read as follows:	
15	PART I-B. WARRANTY CLAIMS ON FARM, INDUSTRIAL, AND LAWN AND	
16	GARDEN EQUIPMENT	
17	§501. Warranty claims submitted to a supplier by a dealer	
18	A. Warranty claims submitted to a supplier by a dealer for payment under	
19	a warranty agreement shall either be approved or disapproved within thirty days of	
20	receipt by the supplier. All claims for payment shall be paid within thirty days of	
21	their approval. When any such claim is disapproved, the supplier shall notify the	
22	dealer within thirty days stating the specific grounds upon which the disapproval is	

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1	based. If a claim is not specifically disapproved within thirty days of receipt, it shall		
2	be deemed approved and payment by the supplier shall be made within thirty days.		
3	B. If after termination of a contract, the dealer submits a claim to the supplier		
4	for warranty work performed prior to the effective date of the termination, the		
5	supplier shall accept or reject the claim within thirty days of receipt.		
6	C. Warranty work performed by the dealer shall be compensated in		
7	accordance with the reasonable and customary amount of time required to complete		
8	the work, expressed in hours and fractions thereof, multiplied by the dealer's		
9	established customer hourly retail labor rate, which shall have previously been made		
10	known to the supplier.		
11	D. Expenses expressly excluded under the supplier's warranty to the		
12	customer shall not be included nor required to be paid on requests for compensation		
13	from the dealer for warranty work performed.		
14	E. All parts used by the dealer in performing warranty work shall be paid to		
15	the dealer in the amount equal to the dealer's net price for parts used, plus a		
16	minimum of fifteen percent. The percentage additive shall reimburse the dealer for		
17	reasonable costs of doing business in performing warranty service on the supplier's		
18	behalf, including but not limited to freight and handling costs incurred.		
19	F. The supplier shall have the right to adjust for errors discovered during		
20	audit and, if necessary, to adjust claims paid in error.		
21	G. The dealer shall have the right to accept the manufacturer's		
22	reimbursement terms and conditions in lieu of the provisions of this Section.		
23	H. For the purposes of this Section, "dealer" shall mean any farm equipment		
24	dealer, heavy industrial equipment dealer, construction equipment dealer, material		
25	handling equipment dealer, utility equipment dealer, engines equipment dealer, lawn		
26	and garden equipment dealer, or retail equipment distributor dealer.		
27	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not		
28	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature		
29	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If		

1	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become		
2	effective on the day following such approval.
