Use of hand-held communication device; prima facie evidence of fault 7 In the trial of any action to recover personal injury or property damages 8 sustained by any party, it shall be prima facie evidence of fault on the part of a driver 9 of a motor vehicle who is involved in a collision while driving and simultaneously 10 using any hand-held electronic communication device.

**Abstract:** Establishes prima facie evidence of fault of a driver using a hand-held electronic communication device while operating a motor vehicle involved in a collision.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that it shall be prima facie evidence of fault on the part of a driver of a motor vehicle involved in a collision while driving and using a hand-held electronic communication device.
