2	To enact R.S. 32:295.3.1, relative to motor vehicles; to provide relative to the transportation
3	of children by day care facilities; and to provide for related matters.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5	Section 1. R.S. 32:295.3.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
6	§295.3.1. Motor vehicles used to transport children; day care facilities
7	The loading and unloading of passengers on motor vehicles owned and
8	operated by a day care center, as defined in R.S. 46:1403, to transport children shall
9	be monitored as to ensure that no child is left unattended in the motor vehicle.
