AN ACT

2	To enact R.S. 40:2133(C), 2133.1, and 2136(C), relative to ambulatory surgical centers; to
3	provide for a definition of a use agreement; to provide authorization for ambulatory
4	surgical centers to enter into use agreements; to provide for promulgation of rules,
5	regulations, and minimum standards; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 40:2133(C), 2133.1, and 2136(C) are hereby enacted to read as
8	follows:
9	§2133. Definitions
10	* * *
11	C. "Use agreement" means a written agreement between a licensed
12	ambulatory surgical center and an individual or entity under which the ambulatory
13	surgical center allows the individual or entity to use its facility, or a portion thereof,
14	on a part-time basis to provide the services of an ambulatory surgical center. A use
15	agreement entered into pursuant to this Part shall comply with all applicable federal
16	laws and regulations.
17	§2133.1. Use Agreement
18	A licensed ambulatory surgical center is hereby authorized to enter into a use
19	agreement as defined in this Part. The licensed ambulatory surgical center shall
20	remain responsible, including during the period of use of an ambulatory surgical
21	center under a use agreement, for compliance with all rules, regulations, and
22	minimum licensing standards for ambulatory surgical centers.
