**Abstract:** Provides for renewal of the Upper Hurstville Security District's parcel fee at any election.

Present law creates the Upper Hurstville Security District in Orleans Parish.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the city of New Orleans to collect a parcel fee on the property within the district in order to fund augmented security within the district boundaries. <u>Present law</u> requires the implementation of the fee to be voted on by the registered voters of the district at an election held in accordance with the La. Election Code. <u>Present law</u> further provides that the parcel fee may be renewed if approved by a majority of the registered voters of the district voting on the proposition. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> requires that an election on the question of renewal may be held only at a mayoral primary election. <u>Proposed law</u> removes this requirement.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
