GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER: Authorizes the La. Gaming Control Board to adjust fuel sales requirements of qualified truck stop facilities

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 27:306(A)(4)(b)(iv), relative to the operation of video draw poker devices; to
3 amend the law regarding fuel sales requirements at qualified truck stops; to authorize
4 the Louisiana Gaming Control Board to adjust fuel sales requirements for qualified
5 truck stops; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 27:306(A)(4)(b)(iv) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §306. State license qualifications; limitations; right to hearing

13 (b) Except as provided for in Subparagraph (7)(a) of this Subsection, the
14 number of video draw poker devices placed at a qualified truck stop facility shall be
15 based on the average monthly fuel sales calculated quarterly for the first year of
16 operation and thereafter shall be based upon the average monthly fuel sales
17 calculated annually as follows:

19 (iv) Notwithstanding the provisions of Items (i) through (iii) of this
20 Subparagraph, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board may adjust fuel sales
