HUNTING: Authorizes the use of sound suppressors when taking nongame nuisance quadrupeds

1 AN ACT 2 To enact R.S. 56:116.1(D)(3), relative to hunting; to authorize the use of sound suppressors 3 when taking nongame nuisance quadrupeds; and to provide for related matters. 4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 5 Section 1. R.S. 56:116.1(D)(3) is hereby enacted to read as follows: 6 §116.1. Wild birds and wild quadrupeds; times and methods of taking; penalties 7 8 D. 9 10 (3) Any person who is authorized to possess a firearm sound suppressor, as 11 evidenced by payment and possession of the required federal tax stamp issued by the 12 Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, may use a firearm fitted with 13 a sound suppressor when taking outlaw quadrupeds, nutria, or beaver under the 14 provisions of this Subsection. 15

**Abstract:** Authorizes the use of sound suppressors when taking nongame nuisance quadrupeds.

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

Present law authorizes the taking of outlaw quadrupeds, nutria, or beaver at any time of year.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the use of a firearm fitted with a sound suppressor for such taking when the person taking the outlaw quadruped is authorized to possess such firearm fitted with a sound suppressor, as evidenced by possession of the federal tax stamp required by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives.
