## AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 3:1400(A)(introductory paragraph) and 1401(C)(1), relative to commercial feeds; to clarify the minimum deficiency assessment; to clarify minimum inspection fees; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 3:1400(A)(introductory paragraph) and 1401(C)(1) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§1400. Deficiency assessments; enforcement

A. If a given lot or shipment of feed is found by official sample and analysis to be deficient in one or more of the guaranteed feeding units, a deficiency assessment of no less than ten dollars shall be assessed against the registrant with respect to the lot or shipment of feed in question in accordance with the following provisions:

C.(1) Except as provided in Subsection E of this Section, each registrant who manufactures a commercial or customer-formula feed for distribution in this state shall pay the commission an inspection fee of one dollar per ton on all commercial feed sold in the state. Payment of the inspection fee shall be made on the basis of

1 tonnage reports submitted to the commission by the registrants of commercial feeds;  
2 however, the minimum inspection fee due for each quarter shall be ten dollars.
