APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Appropriates funds for payment of judgment against DOTD in the matter of "Carl Fruge and Darla Fruge v. State Farm Fire and Casualty Company, et al"

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2012-
3 2013 to be used to pay the consent judgment against the Department of
4 Transportation and Development in the suit entitled "Carl Fruge and Darla Fruge v.
5 State Farm Fire and Casualty Company, et al"; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. The sum of Five Hundred Thousand and No/100 (\$500,000.00) Dollars
8 in favor of Carl Fruge and the sum of Three Hundred Sixty-Seven Thousand and No/100
9 (\$367,000.00) Dollars in favor of Darla Fruge is hereby appropriated out of the General
10 Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2012-2013 to be used to pay the consent
11 judgment against the Department of Transportation and Development in the suit entitled
12 "Carl Fruge and Darla Fruge v. State Farm Fire and Casualty Company, et al", bearing
13 Number 83370-B on the docket of the Tenth Judicial District Court, parish of Natchitoches,
14 state of Louisiana.

15 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2012; if vetoed by the governor
16 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
17 2012, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
