AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 33:1243(A)(1), relative to penalties for violations of parish ordinances; to authorize the imposition of community service as a penalty for violating a parish ordinance; to provide for the maximum number of hours of community service a person may be ordered to perform; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 33:1243(A)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§1243. Maximum penalties

A.(1) Except as otherwise provided in this Section, the maximum penalty which may be imposed for violation of any parish ordinance shall be a fine of five hundred dollars and imprisonment of thirty days in the parish jail. A maximum of one hundred hours of community service may be imposed for a violation of any parish ordinance in addition to, or in lieu of, any penalty provided for in this Section.
