## BY REPRESENTATIVE GREENE

2	To amend and reenact Code of Criminal Procedure Article 415.1, relative to additional
3	grand juries; to authorize the impaneling of one or more additional grand juries; to
4	provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. Code of Criminal Procedure Article 415.1 is hereby amended and
7	reenacted to read as follows:
8	Art. 415.1. Selection of additional grand juries
9	Upon the request of the district attorney, the court shall order one or more
10	additional grand jury juries to be impaneled. Such additional grand jury juries shall
11	be selected in the same manner and have the same qualifications, duties, powers, and
12	responsibilities, and be subject to the same provisions of law which presently govern
13	grand juries, except as to duration and the duty to inspect facilities as provided by
14	R.S. 15:121. However, no grand jury may concurrently conduct an inquiry into any
15	offense or matter or receive evidence of any offense or matter which is under
16	investigation by another grand jury impaneled in the same parish. This These
17	additional grand jury juries shall be impaneled and presided over by the judge who
18	impaneled the existing regular grand jury or a judge appointed by him to act in his
19	absence.
20	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
21	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
22	by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
