1 AN ACT

2 To repeal R.S. 47:6039, relative to tax credits; to repeal the Student Assessment for a
3 Valuable Education (SAVE) credit program.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 47:6039 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

6 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
7 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
8 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
9 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
10 effective on the day following such approval.
