RETIREMENT/REGISTR VOTER: Authorizes a natural or juridical person to serve as director of the Registrars of Voters Employees' Retirement System

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 11:2094, relative to the Registrars of Voters Employees'
3	Retirement System; to provide for the appointment of a natural or juridical person
4	as director; to prohibit a person from serving as both the system director and actuary
5	or auditor; and to provide for related matters.
6	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
7	as provided by Article X, Section 29(C) of the Constitution
8	of Louisiana.
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 11:2094 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
11	§2094. Officers and employees of board
12	<u>A.</u> The board of trustees shall elect from its membership a chairman. $\frac{A}{A}$
13	B. The board of trustees shall by a majority vote of all its members appoint
14	a director, who may be, but need not be, one of its members and may be a natural
15	person or juridical person.
16	\underline{C} . The board of trustees shall engage such actuarial and other services as
17	shall be required to transact the business of the retirement system.
18	D. No person shall at the same time serve as the system's director and
19	provide actuarial or auditing services to the system.

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CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

1	\underline{E} . The compensation of all persons engaged by the board of trustees, and all
2	other expenses of the board necessary for the operation of the retirement system shall
3	be paid at such rates and in such amounts as the board of trustees shall approve.
4	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
5	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
6	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
7	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
8	effective on the day following such approval.

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Abstract: Allows a natural person or juridical person to serve as director of the Registrars of Voters Employees' Retirement System (ROVERS) and prohibits the director from providing actuarial or accounting services.

<u>Present law</u> requires that the board of trustees of ROVERS appoint a director by a majority vote of all board members. Further provides that the director may be a board member. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that the director may be a natural person or a juridical person and prohibits the system's director from providing actuarial or auditing services to ROVERS.

<u>Present law</u> defines a juridical person as an entity to which the law attributes personality, such as a corporation or a partnership.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

- The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Retirement</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:
- 1. Prohibit the system's director from providing actuarial or auditing services to ROVERS.
