Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

HIGHWAYS: Renames the John James Audubon Bridge as the Generals John A. Lejeune-
Robert H. Barrow Bridge

1 AN ACT

2 To rename the John James Audubon bridge being constructed between West Feliciana and
3 Pointe Coupee Parishes the "Generals John A. Lejeune-Robert H. Barrow Bridge";
4 to repeal Act No. 483 of the 1993 Regular Session of the Legislature; and to provide
5 for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. The John James Audubon Bridge, which is currently under construction
8 and connecting the town of New Roads in Pointe Coupee Parish and the town of St.
9 Francisville in West Feliciana Parish shall hereinafter be known and renamed as the
10 "Generals John A. Lejeune-Robert H. Barrow Bridge".

11 Section 2. The Department of Transportation and Development or its contractors are
12 hereby directed to erect appropriate signage and change any promotional type items
13 reflecting this name change.

14 Section 3. Act No. 483 of the 1993 Regular Session of the Legislature is hereby
15 repealed in its entirety.
