HUNTING: Prohibits hunting deer while the animal is swimming or the hunter is in a vessel

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 56:116.3(A)(1)(c), relative to hunting animals; to prohibit taking
3	deer while the animal is swimming or the hunter is in a vessel; and to provide for
4	related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 56:116.3(A)(1)(c) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as
7	follows:
8	§116.3. Special provisions applicable to deer and bear; times and methods of taking;
9	penalties
10	A.(1) No person shall do any of the following:

12	(c) Take deer while the deer are swimming or while the hunter is in a boat
13	with motor attached in operating position; however, the restrictions in this Paragraph
14	shall not apply to any person who has lost one or more limbs vessel, as defined in
15	R.S. 34:851.2(10).

Hensgens HB No. 215

Abstract: Prohibits hunting deer during open deer season while the animal is swimming or the hunter is in a vessel.

<u>Present law</u> contains certain restrictions and prohibitions for deer hunting and hunting of other quadrupeds. Specifically prohibits taking deer while the deer are swimming or while the hunter is in a boat with a motor attached in operating position. Exempts persons who have lost one or more limbs.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the taking of deer during open deer season while the animal is swimming or while the hunter is in a vessel. Defines vessel as a watercraft and air boat used as transportation on the water.
