2	Proposing to add Article X, Section 29(F) of the Constitution of Louisiana, relative to public
3	retirement systems and persons in such systems; to provide for the suspension of

10	Section 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of the members
11	elected to each house concurring, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state of
12	Louisiana, for their approval or rejection in the manner provided by law, a proposal to add
13	Article X, Section 29(F) of the Constitution of Louisiana, to read as follows:
14	§29. Retirement and Survivor's Benefits

17	(F) Suspension of Retirement Benefits. Notwithstanding any provision of
18	this constitution or of any home rule charter to the contrary, the legislature may
19	provide for the suspension of payment of benefits from a public retirement system,

**Abstract:** Authorizes the legislature to provide for the suspension of payment of public retirement benefits to any person who is incarcerated.

<u>Present constitution</u> prohibits diminishing or impairing members' accrued benefits in any state or statewide retirement system.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> authorizes the legislature to provide for the suspension of payment of retirement benefits to any person who is a member of a public retirement system, plan, or fund in La. and who is incarcerated.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held Nov. 2, 2010.
