AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 14:402(D)(9) and (E)(7), relative to contraband on the grounds
3	of correctional institutions; to add component hardware of telecommunications
4	equipment in the definition of "contraband"; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 14:402(D)(9) and (E)(7) are hereby amended and reenacted to read
7	as follows:
8	§402. Contraband defined; certain activities regarding contraband in penal
9	institutions prohibited; penalty; disposition of seized contraband

1	D. "Contraband" as used herein means:

13	(9) Any telecommunications equipment or component hardware, including

attempt to take or send therefrom, or to give or to attempt to give to an inmate of any municipal or parish prison or jail, any of the following articles which are hereby declared to be contraband for the purpose of this Section, to wit:

(7) Any telecommunications equipment <u>or component hardware</u>, including but not limited to cellular phones, beepers, or global positioning satellite system equipment, <u>subscriber identity module (SIM) cards</u>, <u>portable memory chips</u>, <u>batteries</u>, <u>and chargers</u>, whether or not such equipment may be intended for use in planning or aiding an escape or attempt to escape from any institution.

Abstract: Adds component hardware of telecommunications equipment to the definition of "contraband".

<u>Present law</u> prohibits the introduction or possession of contraband on the grounds of any state correctional institution or any municipal or parish prison.

<u>Present law</u> defines "contraband" and includes in that definition any telecommunications equipment, including but not limited to cellular phones, beepers, or global positioning satellite system equipment, whether or not such equipment may be intended for use in planning or aiding an escape or attempt to escape from any institution.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains the provisions of <u>present law</u> and further adds any component parts of the telecommunications equipment including subscriber identity module (SIM) cards, portable memory chips, batteries, and chargers.
