APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Appropriates funds for payment of judgment in the matter of "Marty Taylor, et al v. State of Louisiana DOTD, et al"

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2011-
3 2012 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Marty Taylor v.
4 State of Louisiana, through the Department of Transportation and Development";
5 and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. The sum of Twenty-Five Thousand and No/100 (\$25,000.00) Dollars is
8 hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2011-
9 2012 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Marty Taylor v. State of
10 Louisiana, through the Department of Transportation and Development", bearing Number
11 113,269, Division E on the docket of the Twenty-First Judicial District Court, parish of
12 Livingston, state of Louisiana.

13 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2011; if vetoed by the governor
14 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
15 2011, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
