2	To amend and reenact R.S. 27:93(A)(5)(introductory paragraph), 203, and 205(26), relative
3	to provisions of Title 27 (Louisiana Gaming Control Law) of the Louisiana Revised
4	Statutes of 1950 which are limited in applicability to certain political subdivisions
5	or local areas based upon population classifications; to specify applicability to one
6	or more political subdivisions or local areas; and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 27:93(A)(5)(introductory paragraph), 203, and 205(26) are hereby
9	amended and reenacted to read as follows:

13	(5) In a parish having a population of not less than sixty-two thousand
14	persons and not more than sixty-eight thousand persons, based on the latest federal

Abstract: Updates the applicability of provisions of Title 27 as a result of the 2010 census.

Proposed law, contained in Title 27 (La. Gaming Control Law) of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, legislates with regard to classifications of parishes, municipalities, or other political subdivisions or local areas according to population by enacting local bills to limit the application of laws based upon specific classifications to one or more parishes, municipalities, or other political subdivisions or local areas, by adjusting the population ranges affected by the 2010 census, and by repealing certain provisions based upon certain population classification ranges, as follows:
