2	To amend and reenact Code of Civil Procedure Article 74.2(C)(1) and R.S. 14:75(B) and
3	(C)(4), relative to child support; to provide relative to the venue for a modification
4	of child support; to provide for the parish where the person awarded support is
5	domiciled; to provide for the registration of the support award; to provide relative to
6	the crime of failure to pay child support obligation; to provide for penalties; and to
7	provide for related matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. Code of Civil Procedure Article 74.2(C)(1) is hereby amended and
10	reenacted to read as follows:
11	Art. 74.2. Custody proceedings; support; forum non conveniens
12	* * *
13	C. A proceeding for modification of support may be brought in any of the
14	following:
15	(1) The parish where the person awarded support is domiciled if the award
16	has been registered in that parish pursuant to the provisions of Article 2785 et seq.,
17	regardless of the provisions of Article 2786(A) relative to the domicile of the parties.

19	Section 2. R.S. 14:75(B) and (C)(4) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as
20	follows:
21	§75. Failure to pay child support obligation

23	B. It shall be unlawful for any obligor to intentionally fail to pay a support
24	obligation for any child who resides in the state of Louisiana, if such obligation has

This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 10 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 11 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 12 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 13 effective on the day following such approval.
