Brossett HB No. 27

Abstract: Requires the assessor in Orleans Parish to produce a form for permanent registration of the homestead exemption.

<u>Present law</u> requires tax assessors in certain parishes to provide forms to property owners for permanent registration of the homestead exemption.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds Orleans Parish to those parishes in which the assessor is required to provide such forms.
