2	To amend and reenact R.S. 33:9091.18(F)(1) and (3)(b), relative to Orleans Parish; to
3	provide relative to the Pressburg East Neighborhood Improvement and Security
4	District; to provide relative to the parcel fee collected to fund the district; to provide
5	for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 33:9091.18(F)(1) and (3)(b) are hereby amended and reenacted to
11	read as follows:
12	§9091.18. Pressburg East Neighborhood Improvement and Security District
13	* * *
14	F. Parcel fee. The New Orleans City Council is hereby authorized to impose
15	and collect a parcel fee within the district subject to and in accordance with the
16	provisions of this Subsection.
17	(1) The amount of the fee shall be as requested by duly adopted resolution
18	of the board. The fee shall be a flat fee per improved parcel of land not to exceed
19	two three hundred dollars per year for each parcel.

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(b) If approved, the fee shall expire on December 31, 2015 The initial term for the imposition of the fee shall be eight years, but the fee may be renewed if approved by a majority of the registered voters of the district voting on the proposition at an election as provided in Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph. If the fee is renewed, the term of the imposition of the fee shall be as provided in the proposition authorizing such the renewal, not to exceed eight years.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.

Abstract: Provides relative to the parcel fee that is authorized for the Pressburg East Neighborhood Improvement and Security District in New Orleans.

<u>Present law</u> creates the Pressburg East Neighborhood Improvement and Security District in New Orleans to promote and encourage the beautification, security, and overall betterment of the district.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the governing authority of New Orleans, subject to voter approval to impose a parcel fee within the district to provide funds for the district. Provides that the fee shall be a flat fee per improved parcel of land not to exceed \$200 per year per parcel.

Proposed law increases the maximum fee to \$300 per parcel per year.

<u>Present law</u> provides for expiration of the initial fee on Dec. 31, 2015. Authorizes renewal of the fee, subject to voter approval, for a term not to exceed eight years.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for an eight-year initial term of the parcel fee; otherwise retains present law.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
