HOUSE BILL NO. 29

BY REPRESENTATIVES ZERINGUE AND THOMPSON

APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML: Makes supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 (Item #2)

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds and to make certain reductions from certain sources to be allocated to
3 designated agencies and purposes in specific amounts for the making of supplemental
4 appropriations and reductions for said agencies and purposes for Fiscal Year 2019-2020;
5 to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from the sources specified for
8 the purpose of making supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2019-2020. Reductions
9 are denoted in parentheses.

12 Payable out of Federal Funds to the Executive
13 Administration Program for the Governor's
14 Emergency Education Relief Fund as provided in

17 EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

18 Payable out of Federal Funds to the Administrative
19 Program from the coronavirus relief fund related to
20 the COVID-19 pandemic \$ 700,000

21 DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS

22 03-131 LOUISIANA VETERANS HOME

23 Payable out of Federal Funds to the Louisiana
24 Veterans Home Program for operating expenses \$ 350,000

25 The commissioner of administration is hereby authorized and directed to adjust the means
26 of finance for the Louisiana Veterans Home Program, as contained in Act No. 10 of the 2019
27 Regular Session of the Legislature, by reducing the appropriation out of the State General
28 Fund by Fees and Self-generated Revenues by (\$100,000).

19 **OTHER REQUIREMENTS**

20 **20-XXX FUNDS**

21 The state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer monies from the State
22 General Fund (Direct) in the amount of \$6,227,152 into the Voting Technology Fund.

23 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
24 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
25 by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
26 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
27 effective on the day following such approval.

HB 29 Reengrossed 2020 First Extraordinary Session Zeringue

Appropriates supplemental funding and provides for means of financing substitutions and other budgetary adjustments for Fiscal Year 2019-2020. Provides for net increases (decreases) as follows: Interagency Transfers by \$700,000; Fees and Self-generated Revenues by (\$100,000); and Federal Funds by \$3,912,924.

Increases appropriations from Federal Funds in the Executive Department by \$2,712,924 in the Division of Administration and by \$700,000 in the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness.

Increase appropriations from Interagency Transfers by \$700,000 for the LSU System for the Pennington Biomedical Research Center.

Increases appropriations from Federal Funds by \$500,000 and decreases the appropriation from Fees and Self-generated Revenues by (\$100,000) in the Department of Veterans Affairs.

Decreases the appropriation from State General Fund (Direct) by (\$6,227,152) in the Department of State and transfers that same amount from State General Fund (Direct) to the Voting Technology Fund.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Increase appropriations as follows: Interagency Transfers by \$700,000 and Federal Funds by \$700,000.
2. Make a technical change.
