2	To amend and reenact R.S. 40:4.9(A)(1)(a) and (B), relative to certain food products
3	prepared in the home for public consumption; to provide for application of the state
4	Sanitary Code; to provide for preparation of cane syrup in the traditional manner for
5	sale; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 40:4.9(A)(1)(a) and (B) are hereby amended and reenacted to read
8	as follows:
9	§4.9. Jellies, preserves, jams, honey, honeycomb products, cane syrup, cakes, and
10	cookies; preparation in home for public consumption
11	A.(1)(a) No provision of the state Sanitary Code or any provision of any
12	other law or regulation that requires any equipment, design, construction, utensils,
13	supplies, preparation, or services shall apply to the preparation of jellies, preserves,
14	jams, honey, honeycomb products, <u>cane syrup,</u> cakes, <del>and</del> <u>or</u> cookies in the home for
15	sale. For purposes of this Section, with respect to preparation of cane syrup, "the
16	home" shall mean, in addition to a dwelling, an open-sided structure on private
17	property that shelters a cast iron kettle, evaporator, or other equipment for preparing
18	cane syrup in the traditional manner. This Section shall not be construed to allow the
19	sale or distribution of any unwholesome food.
