INSURANCE/POLICIES: Provides relative to regulation of long-term care insurance policies

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 22:1185, relative to regulation of long-term care insurance
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3	policies; to require review and approval of such individual or group policies by the
4	commissioner of insurance; to clarify the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the
5	commissioner relative to such policies; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 22:1185 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§1185. ExtraterritorialReview and approval required; extraterritorial jurisdiction
9	group long-term care insurance
10	No Any individual or group long-term care insurance policy offered in this
11	state shall be reviewed and approved by the commissioner of insurance, including
12	any group long-term care insurance coverage may be offered to a resident of this
13	state under a group policy issued in another state to a group described defined in R.S.
14	22:1184(4)(d), unless this state has made a determination that such requirements
15	have been met.

Ritchie HB No. 294

Abstract: Requires the review and approval of any individual or group long-term care insurance policy by the commissioner of insurance and clarifies the commissioner's extraterritorial jurisdiction relative to such policies.

<u>Present law</u> provides that no group long-term care insurance coverage may be offered to a resident of this state under a group policy issued in another state to certain types of groups unless this state has made a determination that certain requirements have been met.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that any individual or group long-term care insurance policy be reviewed and approved by the commissioner of insurance, including any group long-term care insurance coverage offered to a resident of this state under a group policy issued in another state to certain types of groups.
