9	Section 1. R.S. 11:1732(11) and (20) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as
10	follows:
11	§1732. Definitions
12	The following words and phrases, as used in this Chapter, unless a different
13	meaning is plainly required by the context, shall have the following meanings:

15	(11) "Disability" means a condition which in the determination of the board
16	renders an employee permanently and totally disabled, by bodily injury or disease,
17	from performing the duties and responsibilities of his position; leaving him
18	incapable of any employment, provided, however, that such condition is not, directly
19	or indirectly, the result of military service, engaging in a felonious criminal
20	enterprise, habitual drunkenness or use of narcotics, intentionally self-inflicted
21	injury, or declared war or enemy action.

(20) "Minor child" means a child born of the marriage or adopted child of a member who has not attained the age of eighteen, or who had a disability at the time of the member's death and who remains in such disability status. an unmarried child under the age of eighteen years or child who had a disability at the time of the member's death and who remains disabled, and "child" means the issue of a marriage of a member, the legally adopted child of a member, the natural child of a female member, or the child of a male member if a court of competent jurisdiction has made an order of filiation declaring the paternity of such a member for the child or the father has formally acknowledged the child. Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2018; if vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1, 2018, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
