HOUSE BILL NO. 311

APPROPRIATIONS: Provides funding to the Dept. of Education to implement Act 952 of the 2003 Regular Session relative to speech-language pathologists and audiologists

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2010-  
3 2011 to the Department of Education for implementation of Act No. 952 of the 2003  
4 Regular Session of the Legislature relative to speech-language pathologists and  
5 audiologists; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. The sum of Four Million Fifty Thousand and No/100 (\$4,050,000.00)  
8 Dollars is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal  
9 Year 2010-2011 to 19-681 Department of Education, Subgrantee Assistance Program, to  
10 provide for full implementation of Act No. 952 of the 2003 Regular Session of the  
11 Legislature, providing a five-thousand-dollar-salary supplement to persons eligible for such  
12 supplement pursuant to the provisions of that Act.

13 Section 2. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, this appropriation  
14 shall constitute full funding for implementation of Act No. 952 of the 2003 Regular Session  
15 of the Legislature.

16 Section 3. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2010; if vetoed by the governor  
17 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,  
18 2010, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
