2	To enact R.S. 39:84.2, relative to budgetary controls on personnel; to require the
3	commissioner of administration to report quarterly on positions, vacancies, and
4	funding for such positions and vacancies; to provide for effectiveness; and to provide
5	for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 39:84.2 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§84.2. Agency personnel vacancy funding report
9	The commissioner of administration shall report quarterly to the Joint
10	Legislative Committee on the Budget on the status of vacancies and the funding for
11	these vacancies. The report shall include the following information for each budget
12	unit in the executive branch with authorized positions and authorized other charges
13	positions in the executive budget:
14	(1) The number of authorized positions and authorized other charges
15	positions for the budget unit and the funding by means of finance associated with the
16	positions.
17	(2) The number of vacant positions and authorized other charges positions
18	for the budget unit and the funding by means of finance associated with the
19	positions.
20	(3) The number of vacant positions and authorized other charges positions
21	for the budget unit that have been vacant for six months or more and the funding by
22	means of finance associated with the positions.

1	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2018; if vetoed by the governor
2	and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
3	2018, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
