WATER/RESOURCES: Provides for the authority to sell the surface waters of Lake Bistineau

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 33:3839, relative to Lake Bistineau; to provide for the authority of certain
3	parish governing authorities to enter into a cooperative endeavor agreement to sell
4	the waters of Lake Bistineau and its tributaries; to provide for terms; to provide for
5	uses of revenue; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 33:3839 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	<u>§3839. Cooperative endeavor agreement; Lake Bistineau</u>
9	A. The governing authorities of all parishes in which a portion of Lake
10	Bistineau is located are hereby authorized to enter into a cooperative endeavor
11	agreement with each other for the purpose of selling the surface waters of Lake
12	Bistineau and its tributaries for irrigation, municipal, or industrial uses. The
13	agreement shall provide that the sales shall not be in conflict with any statewide laws
14	for the management, protection, or regulation of surface water and shall comply with
15	the provisions of R.S. 30:961(B).
16	B. The cooperative endeavor agreement shall provide for the establishment
17	of an advisory board which membership shall consist of one elected official from
18	each signatory of the agreement and one member appointed by the secretary of the
19	Department of Wildlife and Fisheries.

1	C. The funds generated from the sale of water pursuant to this Section shall
2	be expended solely for the benefit of Lake Bistineau and its tributaries, including but
3	not limited to the waters, wildlife, and fish and the construction and maintenance of
4	improvements in and around the lake. Any such funds shall be in addition to any
5	other appropriation of monies from any source for the benefit of Lake Bistineau and
6	its tributaries.

Abstract: Authorizes all parish governing authorities that contain a portion of Lake Bistineau to enter a cooperative endeavor agreement with each other to sell the surface waters of Lake Bistineau and its tributaries.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes all parish governing authorities that contain a portion of Lake Bistineau to enter a cooperative endeavor agreement with each other to sell the surface waters of Lake Bistineau and its tributaries.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that such agreement provides that such sales not be in conflict with any statewide laws for the management, protection, or regulation of surface water and comply with provisions of <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> requires that a cooperative endeavor agreement with an agency or subdivision of the state to withdraw running surface water be in writing, for fair market value, in the public interest, on a uniform form prescribed by the State Mineral and Energy Board, and approved by the attorney general and the secretary of the Dept. of Natural Resources. Provides that fair market value includes the economic development, employment, and increased tax revenues created by the activities associated with the withdrawal of running surface water.

<u>Proposed law</u> further requires that the cooperative endeavor agreement provide for the establishment of an advisory board which shall consist of one elected official from each signatory of the agreement and one member appointed by the secretary of the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that the funds from the sale of surface waters pursuant to <u>proposed</u> <u>law</u> only be expended for the benefit of Lake Bistineau and its tributaries, including but not limited to the waters, wildlife, and fish and the construction and maintenance of improvements in and around the lake. Provides that the funds generated from <u>proposed law</u> shall be in addition to any other appropriation of monies from any source for the benefit of Lake Bistineau and its tributaries.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

- Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Municipal, Parochial and</u> <u>Cultural Affairs</u> to the <u>original</u> bill.
- 1. Specifies that governing authorities of all parishes that contain a portion of Lake Bistineau may enter into a cooperative endeavor agreement with each other.
- 2. Removes provisions that authorize, pursuant to the cooperative endeavor agreement, the establishment of an administrative office and the retention of administrative fees by the office.
