HOUSE BILL NO. 321
BY REPRESENTATIVE FANNIN AND SENATOR WALSWORTH

AN ACT
To amend and reenact R.S. 42:1170(A)(3), relative to mandatory ethics education and training; to exempt uncompensated volunteer firemen and uncompensated auxiliary or reserve law enforcement officers from such education and training; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. R.S. 42:1170(A)(3) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: §1170. Ethics education; mandatory requirements; ethics designee
A.
(3)(a) Commencing on January 1, 2012, each public servant who was not required to complete education and training pursuant to Paragraph (1) or (2) of this Subsection shall receive a minimum of one hour of education and training on the Code of Governmental Ethics during each year of his public employment or term of office, as the case may be.
(b) The provisions of Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph shall not apply to any person who is a public servant solely because he serves as an uncompensated volunteer fireman or an uncompensated auxiliary or reserve law enforcement officer.

CODING: Words in struek through type are deletions from existing law; words underscored are additions.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
