HOUSE BILL NO. 326

APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Appropriates funds for payment of judgment in the suit entitled "Mitzi Allen Scott, et al. v. State of La., et al."

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2010-
3 2011 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Mitzi Scott,
4 individually and on behalf of her minor daughter, Mary Jessica Scott v. State of
5 Louisiana, through the Department of Transportation and Development"; and to
6 provide for related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. The sum of Thirty Thousand and No/100 (\$30,000.00) Dollars is hereby
9 appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2010-2011 to
10 be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Mitzi Scott, individually and on
11 behalf of her minor daughter, Mary Jessica Scott v. State of Louisiana, through the
12 Department of Transportation and Development", bearing Number 0073688 on the docket
13 of the Tenth Judicial District Court, parish of Natchitoches, state of Louisiana.

14 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2010; if vetoed by the governor
15 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
16 2010, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
