AN ACT		
To amend and reenact R.S. 13:1875(12)(c) and 1899(B), relative to the City Court of		
Alexandria; to provide relative to the use of civil filing fees and court costs in		
criminal matters; to provide relative to the general fund of the city of Alexandria; to		
provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.		
Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:		
Section 1. R.S. 13:1875(12)(c) and 1899(B) are hereby amended and reenacted to		
read as follows:		
§1875. Compensation of city judges; particular courts

(c) One-half of civil fees assessed and collected shall be transmitted, on a		
monthly basis, by the clerk of the city court for deposit to the general fund of the city		
of Alexandria used for the operational expenses of the City Court of Alexandria and		
one-half thereof shall be transmitted for deposit to the general fund of the Rapides		
Parish Police Jury.

§1899. Assessment and disposition of costs in criminal cases; costs in juvenile		
matters for specified courts

B.(1) Except as otherwise provided by law, the proceeds derived from these		
costs shall be deposited in a special account which shall be subject to audit, and used		
for the operational expenses of the court or for the payment of clerical fees or other		
similar expenditures as may be approved by the judge.

23	costs shall be deposited in a special account which shall be subject to audit, and used

25	similar expenditures as may be approved by the judge.

27	the operational expenses of the court pursuant to Paragraph (1) of this Subsection,
