2	To amend and reenact R.S. 14:95.1(B), relative to the crime of possession of a firearm or
3	carrying a concealed weapon by a person convicted of certain felonies; to provide
4	with respect to penalties for violations and attempted violations; and to provide for
5	related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 14:95.1(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§95.1. Possession of firearm or carrying concealed weapon by a person convicted
9	of certain felonies
10	* * *
11	B. Whoever is found guilty of violating the provisions of this Section shall
12	be imprisoned at hard labor for not less than ten nor more than fifteen twenty years
13	without the benefit of probation, parole, or suspension of sentence and be fined not
14	less than one thousand dollars nor more than five thousand dollars. Notwithstanding
15	the provisions of R.S. 14:27, whoever is found guilty of attempting to violate the
16	provisions of this Section shall be imprisoned at hard labor for not more than seven
17	and one-half years and fined not less than five hundred dollars nor more than two
18	thousand five hundred dollars.
